



## Pet Boarding Medical Consent

Please review and provide us with this important emergency information. In the unlikely event of an emergency situation arising with your pet, we need to know how to contact you quickly and what your instructions are for your pet's healthcare in your absence. Please choose from one of the following options:

\_\_\_\_\_ Please keep my pet(s) comfortable using minimal treatment & await further instructions as you are contacting me.

*This option only applies to patients who have a DNR Order that has been signed in advance by a NWPH veterinarian.*

In the case of an emergency situation or injury with your pet, our staff will make all attempts to contact you immediately at the emergency contacts you provide us. If we are unable to reach you or your authorized emergency contact, Northwest Pet Hospital, in its sole discretion, will engage our veterinarians to administer medical attention to your pet(s). If your pet's situation is deemed life-threatening or critical in nature by our veterinarians, and requires over-night critical care, we may transport your pet to the veterinary emergency hospital.
